COURSE HIGHLIGHT

LGST233 Health Law and Medical Ethics



Rapid ageing of Singapore's population has increased the emphasis on quality of healthcare. Coupled with better education and exposure, this has led to a rise in the frequency of litigation in this area. An awareness of health law will aid understanding of the issues, including access to healthcare, the physician-patient relationship, informed consent, medical negligence, medical malpractice, regulation of TCM, the Mental Capacity Act, advanced medical directive and health insurance. The course will also explore the critical relationship between the law and the practice of medicine. In doing so, it will focus on the varied approaches to, and multi-layered interrelationships between, ethics, medicine and law, including basic ethical principles and key legal concepts relating to personhood, autonomy, human rights, sanctity of life and quality of life.

The term will commence in the week of 6 January 2020 and classes are expected to be completed by mid-April 2020 (unless otherwise stated). Classes are usually held once a week with a mid-term break between 24 February and 1 March 2020.

General Notes:

- Applicants should be highly proficient in English.
- Applicants, who are from overseas, are not entitled to apply for Student Visa. They will be required to apply for their own Visa / Pass by referring to the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) website - <http://www.ica.gov.sg/>.
- A written confirmation will be sent via email to successful applicants approximately 1~2 weeks before the start of the Term.
- Successful auditing applicants will attend and observe courses taught by our instructors and which are conducted together with the LL.B. and J.D. students. Applicants are exempted from course requirements (such as project assignments, final exams) and are expected to abide by the guidelines of the respective course instructors on class participation.
- For purposes of the course, successful auditing applicants will be granted physical access to the SMU Libraries to refer to the books within the library and may borrow books from the Course Reserves section for use for 2 hours only within the library. Please note that there is no additional borrowing privileges at the SMU Libraries.
- Successful auditing applicants will have no access to the SMU Libraries' electronic databases
